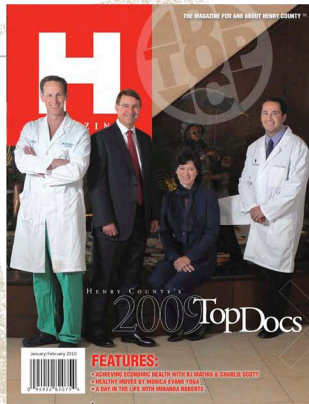


## + Dr. John Schilling

Dr. Muthusamy Sekar earned his medical degree from Madras Medical College, Madras University, India in 1982. He completed a residency in Internal Medicine at State University of New York at Buffalo and a fellowship in Cardiology at the University of South Alabama in Mobile, AL. diologist, was at the hospital that morning when he arrived. Dr. Sekar attended to him in the ER, made a quick decision to keep him overnight for observation and ordered a series of tests, including a stress test for the next morning. After a restless night for Dr. Sekar, he decided to order a cath instead of the stress test. Just a few minutes in to the cath procedure, Dr. Sekar saw the problem. Danny had severe

blockages in both of his main coronary arteries. Danny probably would not have survived the stress test. Within a matter of hours he was transported to Crawford Long hospital for an emergency quadruple by-pass. Dr. Sekar's experience, expertise, and concern for his patient saved my husband's life. We are forever grateful!"
